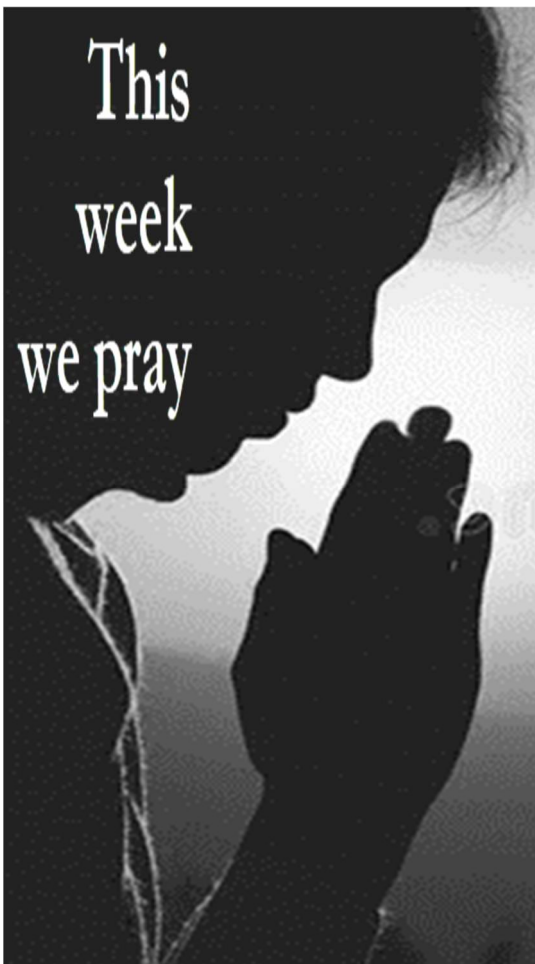
Did you know?

- Family three – Mom and three daughters ages 3, 7, and 9. Mom works at Broadwater. Mom's health has stabilized.

We continue to work on the ramp project. We've had a couple of other issues come up in relation to this and other projects.

We have had a firm come in and complete asbestos testing due to past asbestos issues. We do not have any formal results at this time.

The ramp project is now set to begin after St Peter's hosts the Diocesan Convention in October, we are planning by the end of October 2024.
