- Family two – Dad (34), Mom (24), son (4), and 4-month-old daughter. The family recently moved to Helena from Butte. Mom is caring for kids. Dad is employed. They have their own vehicle.
- Family three – Mom and three daughters ages 3, 7, and 9. Mom is working at Broadwater. Mom's medications seem to be working well and her health has stabilized.

A new program volunteer is currently sleeping at First Christian while searching for housing. Elizabeth has been awarded a housing voucher and is currently looking for a place to rent. Please call the FP office at (406) 465-9467 if you know of an available rental.

Many of you know Denmark and Antwone who were with us last rotation. They found an apartment in town that works well for them to walk to school and work. When we receive a list of their needs, we will email it out.
